

MEMBERSHIP DUES POLICY

Utah Chapter 33 will participate in the IREM National Chapter Dues collection program. The Association Executive will follow all guidelines set in place by IREM Headquarters to remain in compliance with the program. In accordance with the Chapter Bylaws, if the local chapter collects local dues, members shall be assessed dues as follows:

New Member Prorated Invoices

Members that join the Chapter after January 1st may receive a prorated invoice based on the amount of months remaining in the year.

January – 11 months – 92%
February – 10 months – 83%
March – 9 months – 75%
April – 8 months – 67%
May – 7 months – 58%
June – 6 months – 50%
July – 5 months – 42%
August – 4 months – 33%
September – 3 months – 25%
October – 2 months – 17%
November – 1 month – 8%
December – No Charge

Dues Collection - IREM Headquarters will collect dues through April 15th. All dues that have not been collected at that point will be reviewed at the Executive Council Meeting. Assignments will be made to reach out to delinquent members and encourage payment.

Local Member Dues Any member residing or living within 100 miles of the downtown Salt Lake Area will be charged 100% of Chapter Dues.

Outlying Member

Any member residing or living outside 100 miles of the downtown Salt Lake area will be charged 50% of Chapter Dues.

Members with Multiple Designations:

Any member holding more than one designation will be billed the dues rate for the designation that carries the highest dues rate, and the dues for the other designations will be waived.

Honorary Memberships:

- Honorary membership is a status granted to a retired member that is no longer paying IREM dues nationally, and is a past president of the chapter with a history of membership of 10 years or longer prior to being granted honorary membership status.

Honorary membership includes the benefit of attending any chapter event at the member rate or past-president rate. (Payment of National and Local Dues is required in order for an individual to use any IREM designation. Honorary Chapter membership does not allow the member to continue to use the designation.)



Reinstatement

If a member allows their membership to lapse, and within the same year reinstates their membership, that member must pay the full amount of the annual dues.

If a member allows their membership to lapse beyond the initial year of the lapse, and reinstates their membership in a subsequent year, the member reinstating their membership shall be assessed the prorated dues amount according to their membership level for the year of the reinstatement.

Dues Increase/Decrease The Executive Council may choose to increase or decrease the amount of dues owed for the following year, providing the new amount is communicated to the membership no later than September 15th.

IREM HQ COMBINED DUES BILLING PROGRAM The IREM Utah Chapter will participate in any combined dues billing program sponsored by IREM HQ. The IREM HQ process and procedure will supersede the information contained in this policy.
