



PROGRAM/EVENTS POLICY

IREM Utah Chapter 33 is expected to host member events, networking events, education, and other events throughout the year. It is the responsibility of the Executive Council with support from the Program and Events Committee* to ensure that these events are instrumental in fulfilling the strategic goals of the Chapter, support a specific purpose, and have measureable outcomes.

Program and Event Requirements

The Chapter Bylaws require a minimum of 4 member meetings per year.

Program and Event Funding

- Monthly member meetings are included in the dues captured annually. Non dues paying members will be charged a discounted member rate. Guests will be charged a full price that will help cover venue and food.
- Additional events may be self-supporting or may be subsidized by sponsorship dollars.

CE Credit

- Content for monthly member meetings should be submitted for CE Credit through the Utah Real Estate Commission.
- Additional events may qualify for CE credit.

* The Program Events Chair will be chosen by the Executive Council. The Program Events Committee is selected by the Program Events Chair with assistance from Executive Council and comprised of a cross-section of members and Industry Partners that have shown engagement in the current year.
